

1 July Shooting News Oklahoma

A special thanks to all who came out and helped clean up OTA Shooting Park. Thou we got a lot done we will need to have at least one more effort if not more. The tentative date for the next clean up is 27 July 13 from 0800 until noon or later if you wish.

Shawnee had a cleanup day last Friday thanks to Jesse Pemberton, Mr. and Mrs. Robert Rimer and Mr. and Mrs. Mike Meeks for coming out Sunday and finishing up what we didn't get done Friday. We are getting ready for our registered shoot this Sunday and the finish of the State Shoot 13 & 14 July 13.

If enough people show up we will have an unregistered 100 bird event 50 singles 50 handicap from your ATA yardage.
