RULES FOR THIS SHOOT

1. Contestants can complete at any participating club. This shoot is being held simultaneously at all clubs.
2. All scores will be called into a central location- OTA Home ground 405-422-4111, Fax 422-1715 or email to info@trapandskeet.org.
3. All shooters will complete for 1 set of trophies for each event. A total of 84 trophies include champion, runner-up, 1st & 2nd place in all classes yardages, special categories, and HOA classes. HOA categories will be only 1 place.
4. All ties will be determined reverse score by trap form the back, or a shoot off if still tied. HOA ties reverse score by trap on doubles then handicap, then singles.
5. Each club will determine winners at their club and report winners at trap & field for honors only.
6. Oklahoma Grand winners will be reported separately to Trap & Field.
7. Each club will establish their own option on each event for their club.
8. Earned yardage will be punched at each club, based on that clubs scores according to ATA rules.
9. A \$20.00 purse on the handicap will be offered at the 5 clubs. Entries form all 5 clubs will be combined and paid out to 6 places 25,15,10,25,15,10 ties divide. A check with payoff will be mailed the following week.
10. It is the responsibility of special category shooters to declare where entering .
11. Our out of state friends are welcome to compete at any club. Vendors welcome and free campers contact each club.
12. Shawnee and Ada clubs share a lot of shooters so have decided to alternate hosting this shoot each year. Ada will host it this year and Shawnee 2012.

22 Engraved Knives

This is a new shoot which should benefit the shooter. Less travel, shoot at your home club, shoot for Quality Trophies & additional trophies. Please let the clubs know your comments about this shoot.

Note: Oil Capital GC are holding the Eddie Todd memorial Shoot, in conjunction with the handicap of this shoot. \$1600 guaranteed. (for shooters at Oil Capital only). Also plan to attend the 13th Annual OTA Red earth Handicap Shoot Sept. 17th & 18th at OTA-Shooting Park and the National Trap-shooting Day Shoot Oct. 9th.

Facts of this Shoot

Based on shooting all three events, a shooter will have many opportunities to win. Even a D class, 18-yard shooter.

Champion and Runner-up are usually won by either AA or A class shooters, so based on this the number of chances to win are:

Classes AA, A - 16 chances: Singles - Champion & Runner-up,
AA and A Champions & Runners-up

Handicap - Champion & Runner-up, Yardage Champion & Runners-up

Doubles - Champion & Runner-up,
AA and A Champions & Runners-up

HOA - Champion & Runner-up,
AA and A Champions & Runners-up

If a Category shooter, you can add 7 more chances to the above 16 for a total of 23

Classes B, C, and D chances: Singles - Class Champion & Runner-up,

Handicap - Yardage Champion & Runners-up

Doubles - Class Champions & Runners-up,

HOA - Champion & Runner-up,
AA and A Champions & Runners-up

If a Category shooter, you can add 7 more chances to the above 8 for a total of 15

Even a category shooter who has to accept category in every event still has 7 chances to win a trophy. With 84 trophies available, and based on a minimum of 125 entries, it is possible that two-thirds of the shooters could win a trophy. Considering some shooters will win 2 or 3 trophies, it is still possible 40 to 50% of shooters may win trophies. Even if you are a AA shooter competing against a top shooter who happens to win all 3 events and HOA, you still have 12 chances to win a trophy! Even if a B,C, OR D class shooter wins all 3 events, and the HOA, it still leaves 4 chances to win a trophy.
