

OTA January 2012 News Letter

The OTA Shooting Park will be open on Dec 31 and closed on Jan 01.

The Shawnee Twin Lakes Trap Club will be open on Dec 31 and Jan 01.

From our ATA Delegate Larry Parsons:

There have been several happenings at the ATA, concerning changes in categories and Hcp yardages. There will be some new categories added this year and they will count for All American pts. The first change is in Lady Category, There will be a Lady 1 which consists of Ladies under 55yr old. Lady2 will be 55 and over. These will apply to the State Shoot and Zone shoot, not our monthly shoots at this time. The next change is a Junior Gold category which will be 18yrs old to 24 yrs old. The same applies for it, State Shoot and zone, not our monthly shoots. The last category change will be Sub-Veteran 55yr-64 yr old. The same as above applies to it only State Shoot and zone not monthly shoots. The categories that you have been shooting will still apply to our monthly shoots until further notice.

The next change is a 2yd Hcp reduction to be offered as a onetime deal to anyone below the tipping point in our zone. The tipping point is a 90 avg. Almost all codes will be dropped and singles average restrictions etc will be ignored for this offer. I don't have all the information at this time but I think ATA wide as many as 21,000 people will qualify. There will be a lot of shooters eligible for this and as I have more information I will pass it along to you. There will be a lot of people moving forward 2 yards so think this over very carefully before you turn this reduction down. As I say I will have more information after the first of the year about it and I think they want to do this in the near future. As they say stay tuned for more.

Finally the Okla. City Gun Club Shotgun division is going to hold a Trap Derby on Jan 29 the 5th Sunday of the month, the way I understand no matter the weather that day. The shoot will start registration at 10 am and Shooting will start promptly at 11 am. ATA 3 class system classes A,B,C will be used same as OTA. There will be 50 target events, singles, Hcp, and doubles. Each event will have a \$20 entry fee, depending on the number of entrants divided either 60/40 or 50/30/20. There will be a free Hot dog lunch provided. For more info call Paul Hooper at 405-535-2720. I would like to see a good attendance, and maybe there

will be opportunities for other shoots in the future. More places to shoot will benefit all shooters in the state. The location is east on hwy 66 from I35 in Edmond to Hiawasse rd then north 3.3 mi to the shotgun sports division sign on the west side of the road.
